

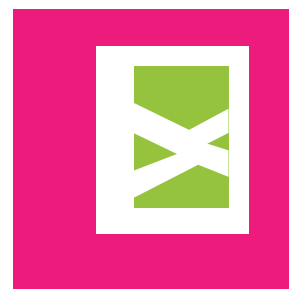
CMQG Modern Art Lottery Block

FABRICS: **3 solids**—white and two bold saturated colors

FINAL SIZE: **12½" x 12½"**

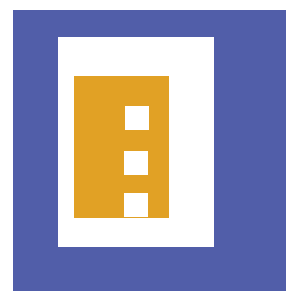
1 Create a two-color mini modern art masterpiece.

Using only white and one of your colored fabrics, create a block of **anything you want**. Sew stripes, Xs, circles, anything at all, as long as it is only white and one color. Create an abstract portrait of your cat, visualize how you felt when you woke up this morning, copy your favorite contemporary artist... anything you want—it's your modern art piece. Be bold. Trim it to **4½" x 6½"**.



2 Border it in white.

Add a strip of white fabric that is anywhere between 1" and 2½" wide to each side of your art piece. Don't use the same width for all the sides.



3 Frame it color.

Add strips of your second color to each side (again not making the borders the same widths). Add enough to bring the block up to **12½" x 12½"**. That's a 12-inch final block with a ¼" seam allowance on all sides.
